celebrity colorist tracey cunningham reveals spring's top trends.

TRACEY CUNNINGHAM KNOWS plenty about trends—from Hilary Duff to Lily Aldridge, the Los Angeles-based colorist's client list reads like a who's who of young Hollywood. If you've seen a celebrity's hair you've wanted to copy, chances are, Cunningham was behind it. "Everyone still wants ombre," she says of the dark-to-light hair color craze she helped start. "Jessica Biel, Hilary Duff, Emily Blunt have all done it. I even did it on Emma Stone when she was still a redhead because she wanted a new look when she was between jobs." Almost a year after it started, Cunningham says the two-toned look isn't going anywhere. "It's the craziest thing, but I think it's still so popular because it's freedom from roots. Girls with dark hair can finally have light hair, even if it's just at the ends." What Cunningham doesn't love so much is overdone color: "I don't like a frosted look, when a girl with really dark hair goes really, really blond. I hate it." In fact, she wishes a natural look was more popular—whether it's virgin hair, or natural-looking color. "You can just do gloss over your natural color, which gives it a sheen without changing the color. It enhances what's already there."
